FY 2025-2026 City of Roanoke Budget Community Meetings

Did You Know? Let's Talk about Traffic 🌑 🚸 🚗 🚙

Traffic is the #1 concern of the residents of GDNA based on survey results and conversations. GDNA has had multiple conversations with City of Roanoke Traffic engineering to understand what options are available for traffic calming. Unfortunately, based on traffic statistics - the Greater Deyerle Neighborhood is not considered high-risk and based on traffic statistics (crashes) - our neighborhood ranks very low. There were six crashes within our neighborhood that resulted in injuries and three that resulted in property damage. That is out of 2092 reported traffic incidents in Roanoke City in 2024. GDNA will continue to work with the Roanoke City traffic to look at all options available to help with traffic calming in Greater Deyerle. Key takeaway - we are actively working on this issue.
